- Achilles' heel The only weakness of a strong person.
 Eg. The lack of motivation is his/her Achilles' heel
- Get up and go/ push/zip energy
 Eg: recognition will give her that push/zip to win.
 When they made me the team leader, I got get and go.
- Hats off expression on congratulation.
 Eg: You have really rocked. Hats off
- Take no denial Compulsion.
 Eg: The baby would take no denial, at last her mother had to buy that doll.
- Ivory valuable (figurative)

Eg: That little doll was the ivory for Lamya.

Not grow on tree- not easily available/rare
 Eg: diamonds don't grow on trees.
